

Registration Information

Player Registration opens April 1st, 2011. If you have already created an account last year, please use the member log in button on the top left corner.

ONLINE REGISTRATION

Molalla Youth Football registration is an online process only. All children in grades 3 through 8 (entering in the fall of 2011) living in the Molalla River School District boundaries are eligible to play. Players are not accepted as official registrants until the registration is paid in full and all mandatory forms are turned in. The registration fee, the TVYFL Medical Release form, player registration contract, and the MYF parent contract are due at time of registration.

Early registration will run from April 1st – **June 1st, 2011**. Late registration will be from June 2nd – July 1st, 2011. The cost to register for the 2011 season will be **\$235 for early registration** on or before June 1st, 2011 and \$260 if you register after June 1st, 2011. **Understand that if you register before June 1st and do not pay your fees in full by that date, you will be assessed the late fee and will be required to pay the \$260. NO EXCEPTIONS!**

There will also be an **equipment deposit fee of \$300 per player** due at the time of gear issue. The equipment deposit is not cashed; it is held by MYF and then returned to you at the end of the season once gear is turned in. No deposit, no gear.

If you are unable to register online please call our Registrar, Lisa Banyard at 503-789-5392. **ONLY CALL HER IF YOU ARE NOT ABLE TO REGISTER ONLINE!**

All returned checks will be charged a \$25 processing fee.

Before you click on "Register Online Now" please be sure to have ready or do the following:

1. Your medical insurance information
2. Your credit or debit card number. (You may also pay by check or money order.)

FORM REQUIREMENTS

We have streamlined the process so that there are only **3 forms you must complete, sign and return to Molalla Youth Football before we can release equipment**. They include the Medical Release Form, Molalla Youth Football Parent Contract, and the Player Registration Contract you receive via email after you register online. Be sure that all forms are signed.

TVYFL Medical Release Form

All players must have a physical and/or Doctor's release to participate in the football program. The league will accept the signed Medical Release form from anyone licensed or approved by the State of Oregon to perform physicals. Form must be dated after February 1, 2011 (**physical may happen prior to the February 1 date**) and **must be on the Tualatin Valley Youth Football 2011 Medical Release Form**. Please also be sure that there is a Parent Signature.

Molalla Youth Football Parent Contract

Molalla Youth Football has strict policies regarding conduct of not only the players, coaches, and board members, but of our parents as well. Please read and sign the acknowledgment that you understand our position on issues as well as conduct we expect from the parents of our players as well. This form is on our website and can be found under the forms tab.

REFUND POLICY

Once sign-up fees have been paid to MYF, the fees will be refunded as follows:

- a. From the date the sign-up fee is paid and paid only in full up until July 1st, 25% of the fee will be refunded. If registration fee is not paid in full there will be no refund.
- b. After July 1st, there will be no refunds.

WAITING LIST

Registration submissions will be prioritized for acceptance of the player into Molalla Youth Football based on registration/payment date, i.e. a "first come, first served" basis. Acceptance is based on filling the maximum players per level. Any registration submissions after the closing registration period will be subject to a non-refundable late fee.

SCHOLARSHIPS

Molalla Youth Football is committed to maintaining a structure so that we can provide children from all economic backgrounds the opportunity to participate in our youth football program. We are 100% dependant on registration fees, fundraisers, and sponsors to meet the many necessary expenses of our program.
